

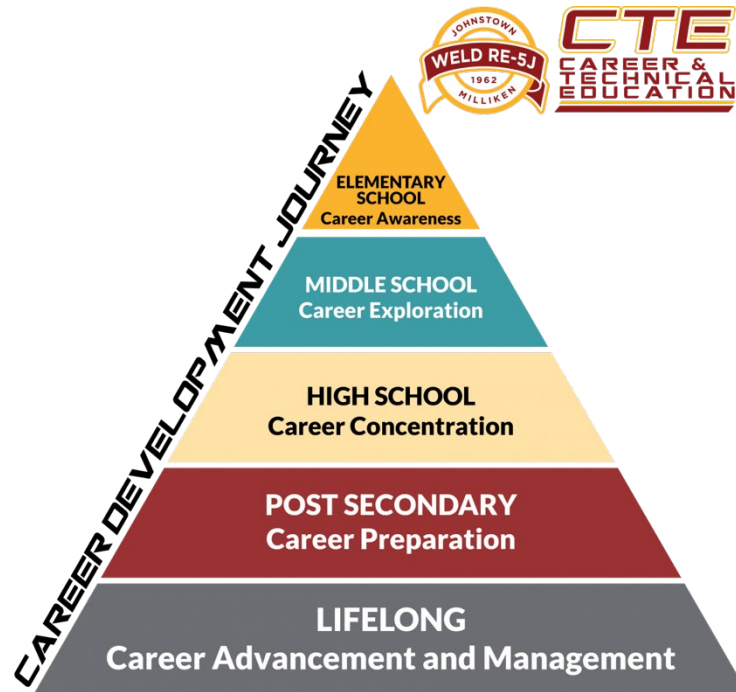


READY FOR THE FUTURE >>>
